Club Awards will be based on percentages. Throughout the year, the percentage will be figured based on those who participate versus club enrollment. At the end of the year, these percentages will be totaled.

Clubs of the Year

The Clubs of the Year will be determined based on the highest percentage average, county-wide. A minimum of 80% participation for the yearly total is required to be eligible for this award. These clubs will be recognized with a banner to keep and display in their room and receive a classroom ice cream celebration. The Club of the Year teachers will receive a gift card as well! Clubs of the Year will be awarded county-wide to the top 2 clubs for 4th, 5th, and 6th grade.

Gold Level Clubs

Gold Level Clubs will be presented at each school for the top-scoring club.

Clubs must receive a minimum score of 65% for the yearly total to be
eligible for this award. Club of the Year winners are not eligible for this
award. Each Gold Level Club will receive a banner to keep and proudly display
in their room!

Percentage scores will be given in the following areas:

- 1. Club Meetings (4 individual scores)
 - November, January, February, and March)
- 2. Club Events (4 individual scores)
 - $\circ\,$ November # of speeches given in the classroom
 - January # of posters entered in the county contest
 - February # of **essays** entered in the county contest
 - January # of photos entered in the county contest
- 3. Attendance for the county-wide 4-H Officer Training
- 4. Attendance for the county-wide 4-H Speech Contest
- 5. Golden Eagle Award Winners
 - Total number of Golden Eagle Awards earned per club
