Preparing for your demonstration!

• Select your topic!

- Must relate to a 4-H Project Area (see back for project list)
- Choose a topic you know something about, or enjoy talking about.

Decide how you will teach your topic.

- Use step-by-step instructions
- Be specific and explain what you are doing.

Select Materials

- Use supplies and props to demonstrate with
- Follow school rules (nothing dangerous or against school policy)
- No live animals!
- Be Creative!

• Design your posters.

- Use a trifold board, poster, or set of posters.
- List your steps and supplies on your poster(s).
- Include a Title!

Format and practice your presentation.

- Introduction
- "Show and Tell" all of your materials
- Step-by-Step Instructions
- Conclusion
