

Your child is invited to participate in The University of Tennessee Extension's 4-H Piggy Bank Pageant. To enter, he or she will need to use imagination and creativity to handcraft a Piggy Bank. The guidelines are attached to this letter. The Piggy Bank Pageant is a county-and state-level Extension activity designed to help young people start the habit of saving early in their lives. County winners in each category will be eligible for a statewide contest held in April. First, second, and third-place entries in each grade category will be awarded small prizes at the county and state levels.

We hope you'll take this opportunity to encourage your child to make a Piggy Bank and talk to him or her about the importance of saving money. There are huge benefits to saving early in life!
