Failure to meet this requirement will result in ineligibility to compete, and fees will not be refunded.

<u>Divisions Offered - Trap, Skeet, & Sporting Clays</u>

- 4-H Season practices will focus on Trap and Skeet
- Athletes in grades 5-7 (as of Jan 1, 2026) shoot trap only, and grades 8-12 (as of Jan 1, 2026) shoot trap and skeet.
- Athletes also have the option to shoot sporting clays.

Trap & Skeet Practices - DAYS AND TIMES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE

- Junior and Senior Squads will practice trap on Mondays at 4:30 PM, starting February 9
- Senior Squads will practice skeet one Saturday a month at 9:00 AM, starting February 21st
- 4-H Season practices will be conducted from February to May
 - An extended season option shooting SCTP is available, and those practices will be conducted from May - July
- A parent is required to attend each practice with athletes under the age of 16
- Athletes must shoot at least 800 targets at team practices
 - Failure to meet this requirement will result in ineligibility to compete, and fees will not be refunded.
- Location:
 - Trap practices will be conducted at: Hog Heaven Gun Club (White Pine, TN)
 - Skeet practices will be conducted at Greene County Range & Firearms (Greeneville, TN)

Sporting Clays Practices

- Practices will be conducted from February to July
- A parent is required to attend each practice with their athlete
- If parents wish to go through the course with their athlete, they must provide their own cart
- Athletes must shoot at least 800 targets at team practices
- Locations:
 - o Greene County Range & Firearms (Greeneville, TN)
 - o Iron Mountain Sporting Clays (Kodak, TN)



Age Requirements

The Sevier County 4-H Shooting Sports program is open to current 5th-12th graders, as of Jan 1, 2026. Any 4-H member under 16 must be accompanied by a parent/guardian over 21 at practices and events. A 16-year-old member cannot bring underage siblings or other 4-Hers.

Attendance

4-Hers are expected to attend team practices resulting in at least 800 practice targets. Competition registration fees will be covered for 4-Hers who meet this requirement. Registration fees will not be paid for 4-Hers participating in less than 800 practice targets.
