Team Practice Participation and Conduct Rules for State Competition Eligibility

1. Minimum Practice Requirement

 All team members must attend a minimum of 9 scheduled practices by April 28 to be eligible to compete in the state competition.

2. Tracking Attendance

 Attendance will be recorded at each practice, and coaches will monitor each athlete's progress toward meeting the minimum attendance requirement.

3. Absences and Excused Exceptions

 Absences may be excused for valid reasons, such as illness, family emergencies, or academic obligations, provided the coach is notified in advance. However, excused absences do not count toward the 9-practice minimum.

4. Expected Conduct

- All team members are expected to use appropriate language at all times.
 Roughhousing, inappropriate language, and any behavior that could harm others or disrupt practice are strictly prohibited.
- Team members must demonstrate respect toward all adults, teammates, and coaches.
 Treating others with respect is essential for maintaining a positive, supportive team environment.

5. Fundraising Participation Requirement

- Each team member is required to participate in designated fundraising efforts to help support team expenses. Fundraising is an essential part of ensuring all athletes have access to resources for a successful season.
- Failure to participate in required fundraising activities may impact the athlete's eligibility for competition and team events.

6. Consequences

 Athletes who do not meet the minimum of 9 practice attendances by April 28 or fail to follow conduct rules will be dismissed from the team.

7. Commitment to the Team

 Participation in practices enhances individual performance and strengthens team dynamics and strategy. Athletes are encouraged to attend all practices and follow conduct expectations to support their teammates and personal growth.
