4-H Poster Contest - Two Options, One Contest

REGULAR POSTER or DIGITAL POSTER – **You may enter only 1 poster**

RULES:

- Make a poster on Board 14 x 22 inches. This is a one-half sheet of poster board.
- Design your poster horizontally.
- NO GLITTER.
- You must promote 4-H and **include the 4-H emblem**
 - No 3-D objects
 - Nothing should be placed on or blocking the 4-H emblem (clover)
 - The stem of the leaf of the clover should always turn to the right
 - The 4-H emblem should not be placed under words or graphics
 - Use the whole 4-H emblem; do not distort or warp the dimensions
- No copyrighted cartoon characters, such as Mickey Mouse, Bugs Bunny, etc.
- Posters must be the original work of the participant.
- AI-generated artwork, text, or images are NOT permitted.
- If photographs are used, they must be original photos taken by the participant. Stock photos or images found online are not allowed.
- Back of the Poster - put your first and last name, school, grade, teacher's name, home address, and parent email. If you do not have this information on the back of your poster, IT WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED A WINNING POSTER.

SUGGESTIONS:

- Be creative. Develop a catchy phrase and illustrate that thought.
- Keep it simple. Letters should be large enough to be read from a distance. NO GLITTER!

AWARDS:

- Each participant will receive a ribbon.
- Each participant will earn participation points for your club score.
- Winning posters from each club will be selected for the county competition.
- Three county winners will be selected for physical and digital. The winners will each receive \$25.00. Other small cash awards will be presented (depending on the funds available).
- County-winning posters will be selected for entry in the State 4-H Poster Contest.
